


Windows Live Mail Setup Guide


⇒ Open Windows Live Mail

(Start > All Programs > **Windows Live Mail**)

In Windows Mail Click on “**Accounts**” and then Click on the “**Email**”



⇒ Now enter your **email address**, this may vary depending on your service, you can usually find it on your

⇒ And then enter your **password** and a **Display name** and press “Next”,


Note Display Name is the name that is displayed to the recipients of your email, this does not need to match your account name and examples are;




