
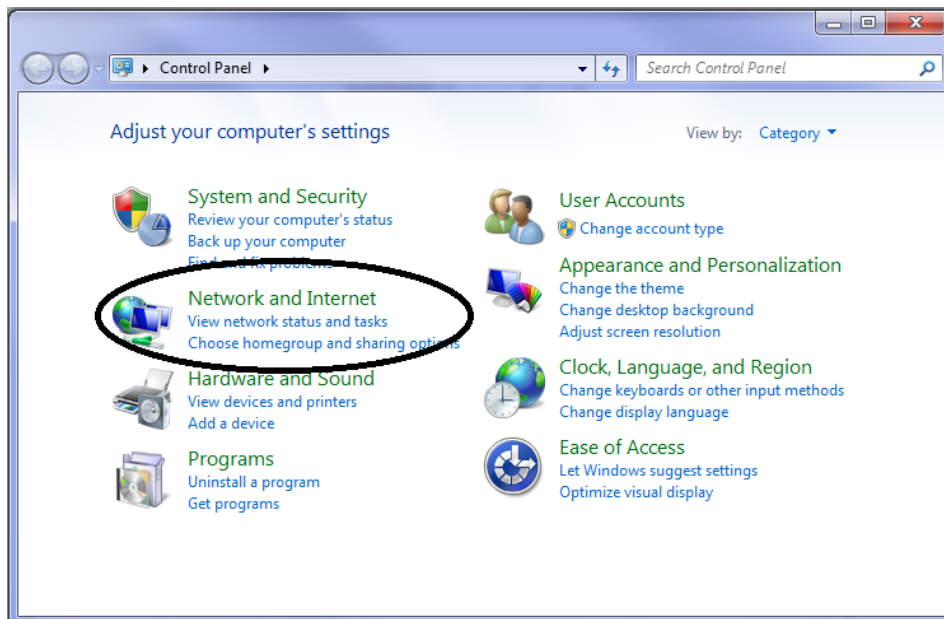
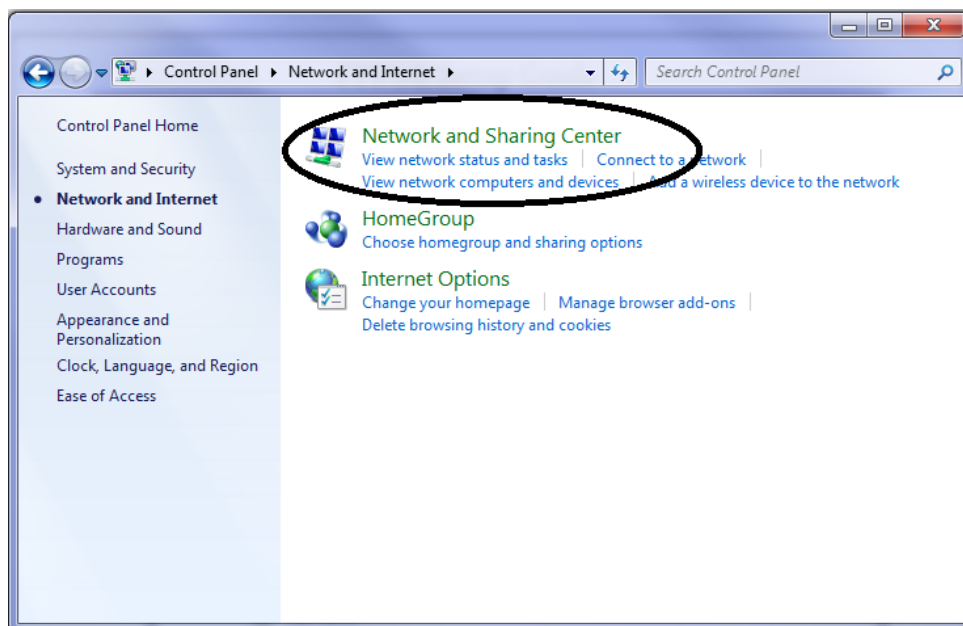


Dial Up Connection Setup Guide

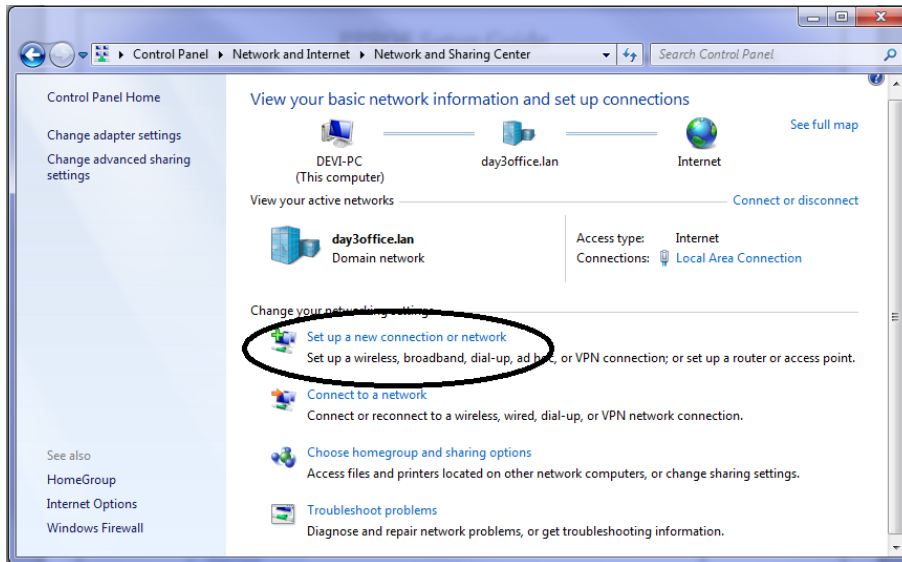
⇒ Open the Connect to the Internet wizard by clicking the **Start** button , clicking **Control Panel**, clicking **Network and Internet**,



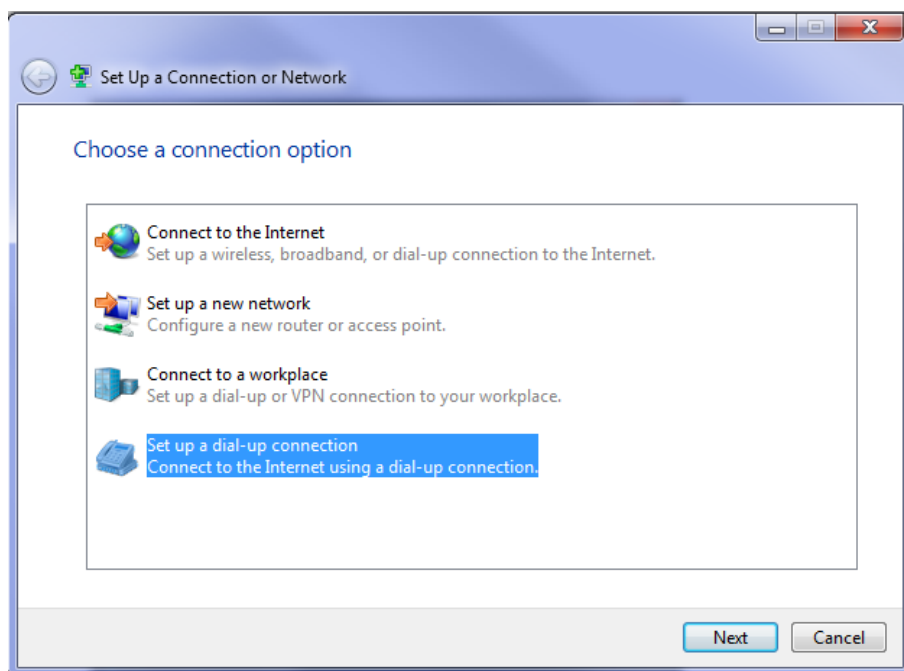
⇒ click **Network and Sharing Center**,



⇒ Click on **Set up a connection or network**,



⇒ Click **"Set up a dial-up connection"** then click **"Next"**

Show Characters: Check this box to ensure you typed your password correctly


Remember this password: Check if you do not want to key in your password to access the Internet.

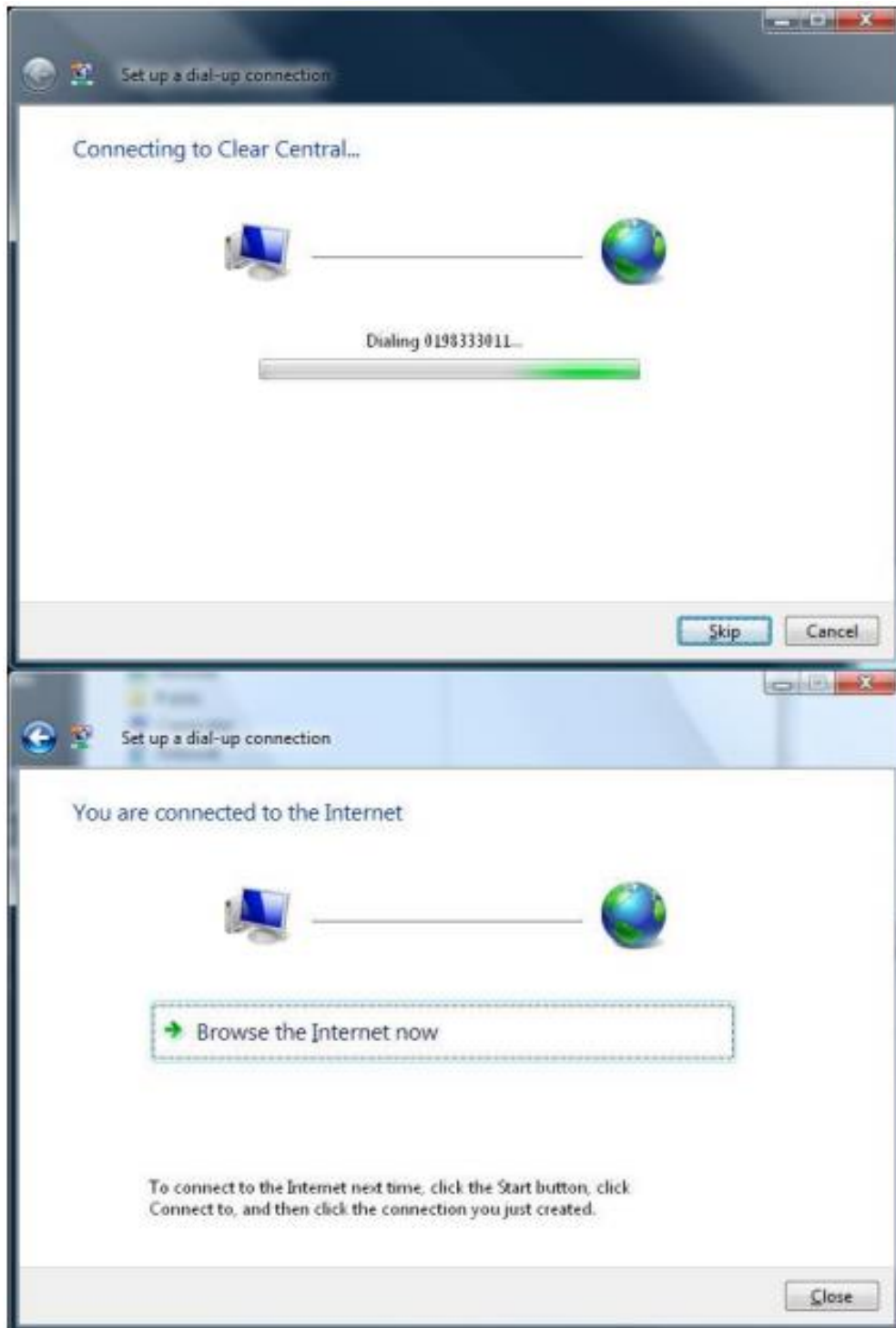
